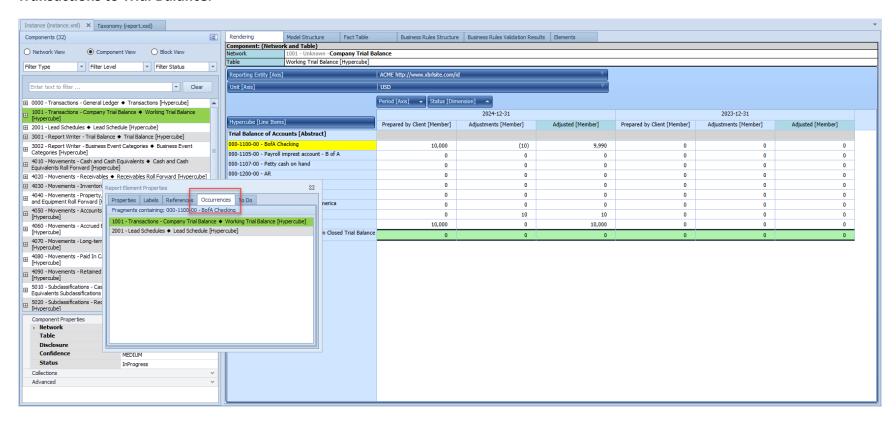
Track, Trace, Walk (a.k.a. "Audit Trail" and "Drill Down")

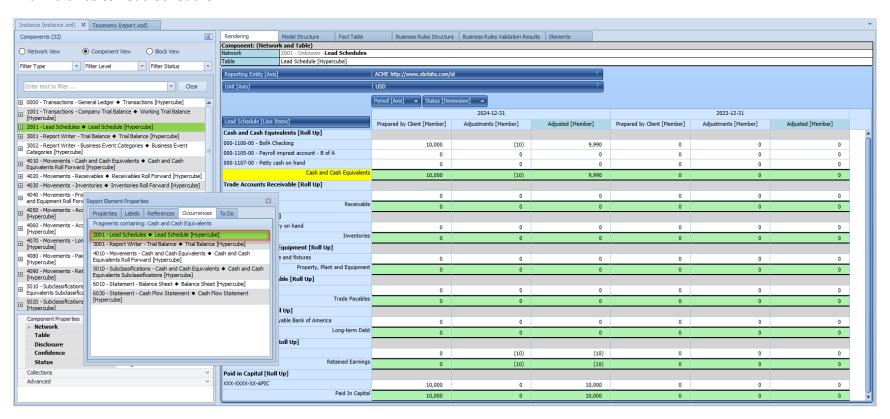

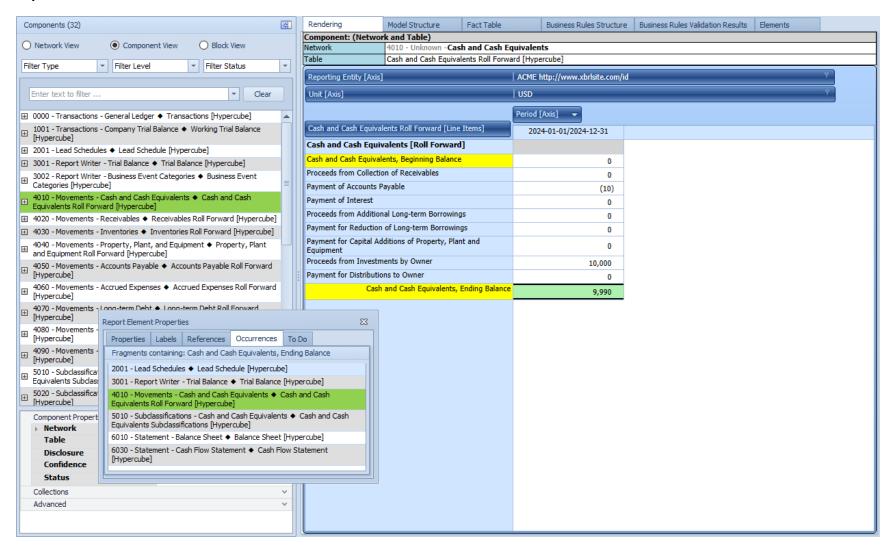

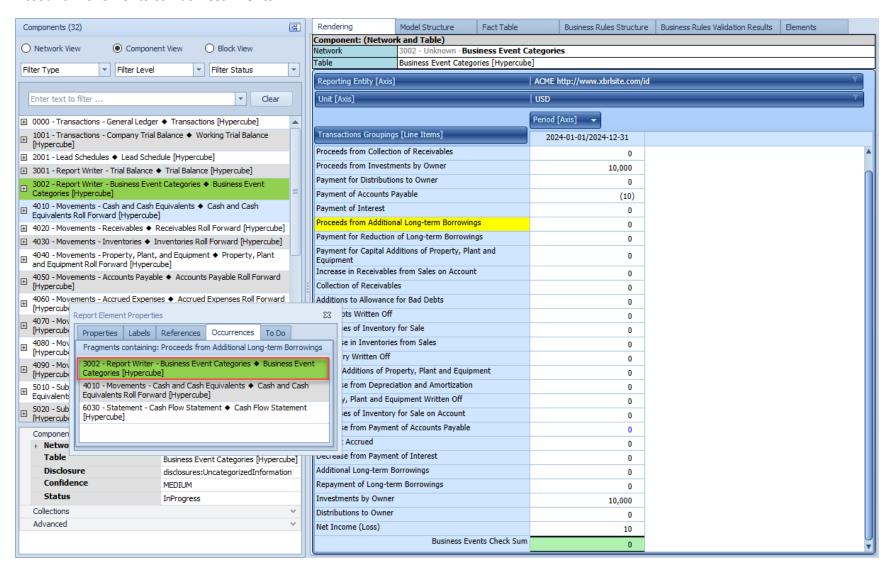

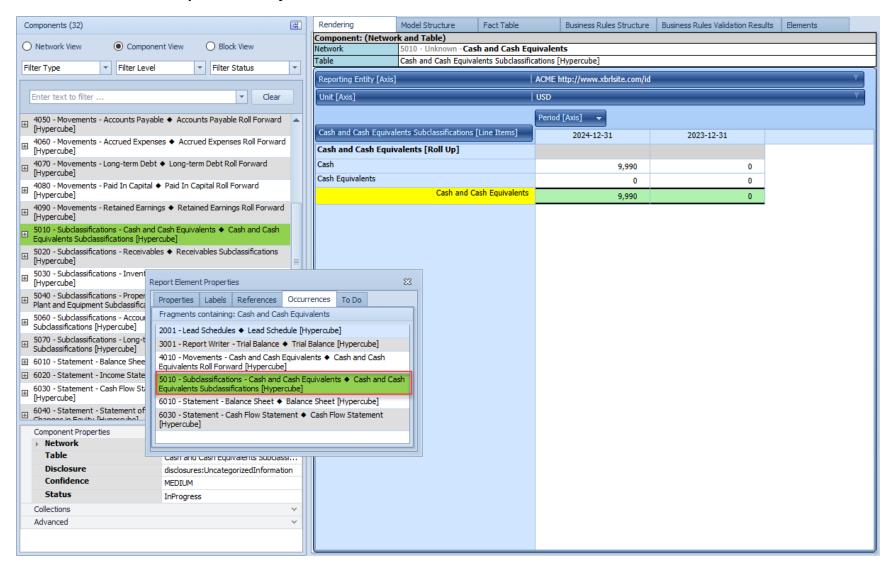

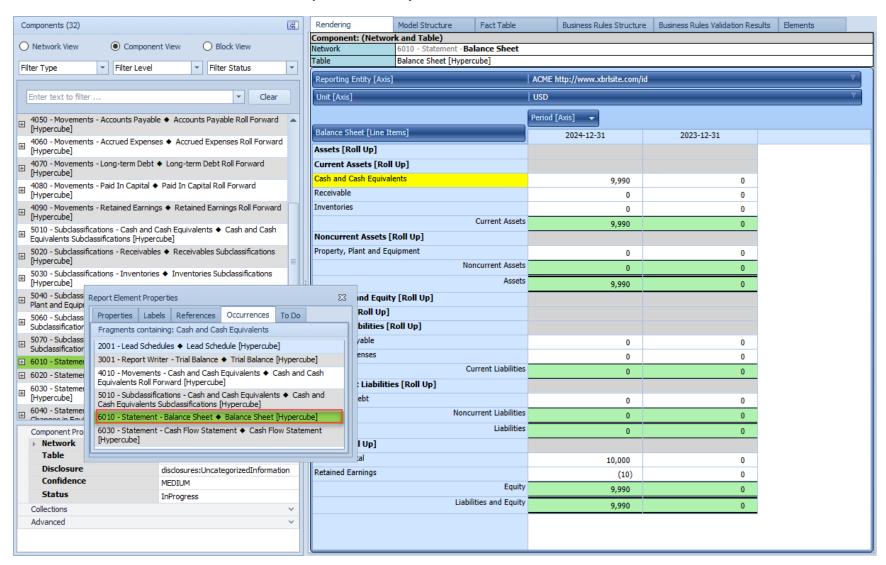

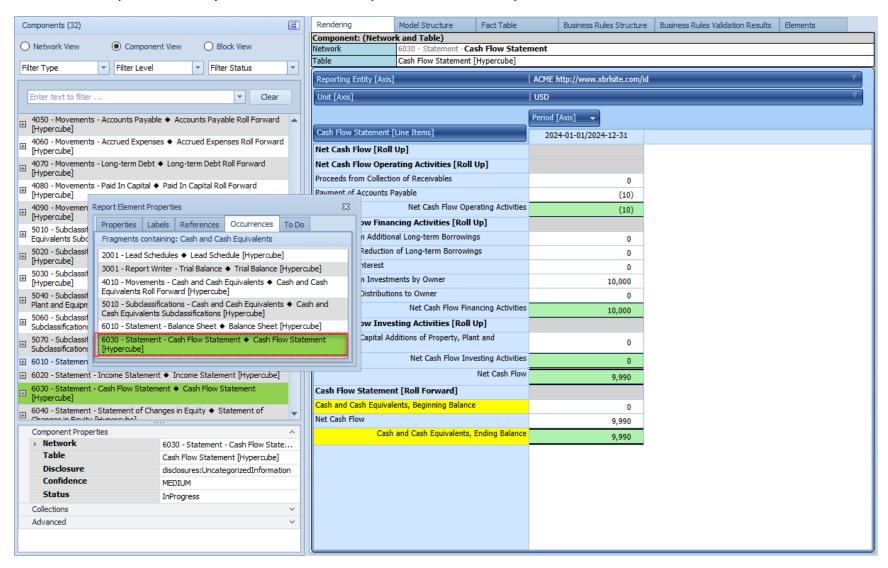
