

## **Overview of Comprehensive Example (2010-08-01)**

The Comprehensive Example strives to achieve two things. First, combine all of the Business Use Cases into one XBRL instance and XBRL taxonomy for the purpose of testing the relations between the Business Use Cases. (i.e. in the Business Use Cases themselves, each use case is in a separate XBRL instance and XBRL taxonomy so you don't get to look into the interaction between the use cases.) Second, this example is designed to have the characteristics of a financial statement but without being overly complex like most financial statements tend to be.
